#### **Business Session #4**

Al Regulation in Japan

Speaker: <u>Hironao Kaneko</u> (Associate Professor at Institute of Science Tokyo)

The Tokyo 2025 Deaflympics, a competition for hearing-impaired athletes, will be an opportunity to develop assistive devices using AI technology, such as screens that display text for conversations. Technologies can apply to communication tools for all people with interpretation functions. However, a risk of discrimination may be caused due to bias of AI system. Especially, accessibility is crucial to realizing an equal society.

The EU has implemented the "Directive on the Accessibility Requirements for Products and Services," to promote the purpose of the United Nations Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities. Small and medium-sized entities exporting products and services to the EU must comply with the laws of the destination country. At the same time, EU Artificial Intelligence Act requires "high-risk AI" to comply with the directives ensuring accessibility from the development stage, in accordance with the purpose of the UN Convention.

This presentation, discusses product and service accessibility in the AI era, introducing enacted the Japanese AI Acts.




